Entry Fee: \$10.00 (\$7.50 linage, \$2.50 expenses)

Handicapped at 90% of 220

Advance reservations are highly recommended

Walk-ins will be allowed up to ½ hour prior to the start of the squad depending on lane availability

** No limit for reentries. Each Doubles entry must be with a different partner **

- 1. This tournament will be certified by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by the rules of the USBC and the Allentown Area USBC.
- 2. This tournament is open to youth members participating in a youth program affiliated with a bowling establishment in the Allentown Area USBC Association, Inc. only.
- 3. This tournament will consist of 3 Handicapped Divisions: Boys Singles, Girls Singles and Doubles.
- 4. This will be a handicapped tournament Handicap will be based on 90% of 220.
- 5. An entry fee of \$10.00 per event/per person is required <u>at time of entry</u>. Of this \$10.00, \$7.50 shall pay for linage and \$2.50 for expenses.
- 6. Bowlers must use their highest certified average as of December 1, 2022 with a minimum of 12 games. Proof of average must be submitted with entry.
- 7. There is no limit on reentries. Each Doubles entry must be with a different partner. If qualified in the Singles Event more than once, only the higher scholarship will be awarded.
- 8. Scholarships will be provided to each event by the Association based on \$25.00 per event/per bowler. A 1:5 ratio thereof will be used to determine the scholarship listing. All scholarship funds will be returned 100%, Scholarships will be held by the SMART Program through the United States Bowling Congress.
- 9. Check-in will begin ½ hour prior to the scheduled squad time. Walk-ins will only be accepted if space is available.
- 10. Late bowlers will be allowed to start the game in the current game/frame that the teams are in. Late bowlers will receive a zero (0) for each frame missed.
- 11. Dress code: Clothing may not have any holes or tears. All clothing shall cover all undergarments appropriately, no midriffs, low cut or revealing clothing allowed. All shirts must have sleeves. Full length pants, capris, skirts and skorts are permissible. All skirts, skorts or shorts must be no more than three inches above the knee. Tournament management will have the final say in acceptable apparel.
- 12. All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 29.
